2.1 General

2.2 Applications

These conversion instructions describe the retrofitting of an additional cylinder holder for shielding gas cylinders with 10 to 25 litre content.

These conversion instructions apply to the following welding machines only:

- Tetrix 351, -451, -551 DC
- Tetrix 351 AC/DC
- Tarus 351, -451, -551
- Phoenix 351, -451, -551
- Wega 401
- TETRIX 301, -351; -421; -521 DC
- TETRIX 351; AC/DC
- PHOENIX 351; 401; 421
- WEGA 351; 401; 451



3.2 Preparations



• Screw the plate bracket fixing onto the cylinder holder panel using two threaded grooved pins (M5 x 10mm) as shown in the diagram.





 Screw two "cramps" onto the "cylinder holder panel" using two threaded grooved pins in each case (M5 x 10mm) as shown in the diagram.



3.3 Fixing onto the welding machine

△ WARNING



Risk of injury due to improper handling of shielding gas cylinders! Improper handling and insufficient securing of shielding gas cylinders can cause serious injuries!

- Place shielding gas cylinder into the designated holder and secure with fastening elements (chain/belt)!
- Attach the fastening elements within the upper half of the shielding gas cylinder!
- The fastening elements must tightly enclose the shielding gas cylinder!





3	2	threaded grooved pin M5 x 10 mm	094-015134-00000

• Attach the shielding gas holder to the rear machine panel (cooling air outlet).

The shielding gas cylinder holder must be inserted into the cooling fins on the rear casing panel and aligned carefully over the existing bores and cut-out sections on the casing cover!

• Screw the cylinder holder panel onto the casing cover using two threaded grooved pins (M5 x 10mm) as shown in the diagram.



3.4 Final inspection



△ WARNING

Danger due to failure to carry out the final inspection!

Parts that are incorrectly fitted or that become loose are a source of danger.

- Check all mechanical connections to ensure that they are fitted correctly!
- Carry out the final inspection!
- Carry out the functional test!

Keep the conversion instructions with the machine documentation!

When ordering spare parts, ensure that the item number and serial number of the machine are quoted!
